### Principals update – A look at what the school doing is for our graduates

- 1. Feedback from virtual ceremony compilation 227 students have had their moments of fame walking across the stage at school thanks to all staff and parents who participated. Lots of smiles from the students! Those video clips are now being edited and will be put together by Roll Focus for use in the video production. This will be blended together with the Zone. Aaron Buckham confirmed we have a Claremont Alumni participating it'll be a surprise.
- 2. **Looking ahead at Grad week**, Monday the 22<sup>nd</sup> Chelsea Giordano and Darren Reisig will be announcing district scholarship recipients and additional award recipients, these will be posted.
- 3. **Grad day, June 25<sup>th</sup>** Grads will be at the school to say 'bye' to their Teachers, school envisions a natural and casual experience. Students enter through one door and exit another and will be given their diplomas and blankets as they exit and likely their yearbook. There would be a table outside where the kids will go to pick up these items. Following pick up students depart the school. This is a formal event where all Claremont staff will be there to celebrate the students Logistics for this portion of the day are currently being worked out by the school and will be shared later on. Mr. Westhaver stressed students should wear comfortable foot wear.
- 4. **Note**: This is **NOT** a parent viewing event
- 5. **Dry Grad committee will be volunteering** tasks to be determined as planning evolves
- 6. The plan is to have a google sign-up so friend groups can attend in groups of 25
- 7. Masks have been ordered for all kids for school walk-through will be handed out on entry (these have been supplied by the Grad executive)
  - \*The school will share full details for this portion of the day as planning develops.

#### Dry Grad Parent executive update – this portion of the day is entirely parent run

- The executive is looking into replacing the traditional Dry Grad party with a car parade around Ring Road at UVIC. Students can be dressed up or casual if they prefer. They would decorate their cars and drive slowly around ring road for all parents, grand-parents etc. to cheer them on and wish them well. Still awaiting permission from UVIC and will speak to this further during our next meeting.
- Lisa has communicated with UVIC and although we don't have full permission to proceed with this plan yet
  Questions about marshalling and parking were their biggest concern
- We will be utilizing two parking lots kids back into every other spot we are anticipating to have the Saanich police support this by marshalling and leading the vehicle parade with our Claremont mascot alongside –we will have purple balloons leading the way
- Once details are firmed up we will share a google map of the route inclusive of start and finish points with all Grads and parents.
- Kids to decorate their vehicles before the day's events kick off

- Suggestion made to have: keen grade 11 parents or leadership students to assist in the vehicle parade around ring rd., so grade 12 parents can watch. School and or exec. To look into this.
